#### Dates to Remember

- Dec. 24**—City Hall Closed
- Dec. 25**—City Hall Closed
- Dec. 31**—City Hall Closes at Noon
- Dec. 31**—All animal licenses expire
- Jan. 1**—City Hall Closed
- Jan. 31**—1st installment of Real Estate taxes due to the City Treasurer
- Jan. 31**—Onalaska Personal Property taxes due
- Mar. 31**—Last day to license animals before late fee
- Jul. 31**—2nd installment of Real Estate taxes due to the La Crosse County Treasurer

#### Real Estate Taxes:

- **Payments made through January 31, 2020** must be made to the Onalaska City Treasurer at 415 Main Street, Onalaska.
- Visa, MasterCard and Discover credit cards are now accepted **IN PERSON ONLY** with a 2% merchants fee charge 
- Escrow checks must be endorsed by all parties and will be applied in full to the tax bill. If refunds are applicable, a check will be issued within ten (10) business days.
- **Payments made after January 31, 2020** must be made to the La Crosse County Treasurer at 212 6th Street N. Rm 1900, La Crosse. La Crosse County accepts cash, check and credit cards.

#### Personal Property Tax:

- All personal property tax must be paid in full to the Onalaska City Treasurer **on or before January 31, 2020.**

#### Christmas Trees:

Curbside pickup is available the week of January 13<sup>th</sup> - no later than 5 a.m. the same day as your regular refuse pick up day. Trees placed in a disposal bag will not be



picked up. **Yard Waste:** April - Nov. The 2020 Yard Waste stickers will be available for purchase for \$20. Due to the **IMPORTANT CHANGES** with Yard Waste pickup, please see your 2020 Recycling Brochure or the City Website: [www.cityofonalaska.com](http://www.cityofonalaska.com) for more details. 

#### Refuse & Recycling:

The 2020 Recycling Brochure will be mailed prior to December 31st.

\*During winter months please do **NOT** put your garbage/recycling carts in the street. This interferes with snow plowing.

#### Snow Removal:

Sidewalks must be cleared of ice & snow within 24 hours after a snowfall. Do not push or blow snow onto streets/sidewalks or other properties.



#### ANIMAL LICENSES

**Remember To Send A Self - Addressed Stamped Envelope For Return Of Tags!!**

You will need to provide documentation of proof of rabies.

\*All dogs and cats five (5) months and older must be licensed.

\*If your pet has not been previously licensed or has since been fixed, you must also provide proof of spay or neuter.

Spayed/Neutered—\$14.00  
Unaltered —\$25.00  
Late Fee (after 3/31)—  
\$25.00 Per animal

\*\*Any dog renewals after March 31, 2020 need to be paid (including late fee) to: **La Crosse County Clerk's Office—212 6th Street N. Rm 1500, La Crosse, WI 54601.**
