WHEREAS, the City of Onalaska Comprehensive Plan encourages transportation systems that includes bicycle facilities and encourages cooperative efforts to further build upon a countywide bicycle-pedestrian trail system that provides safe and efficient routes to interconnect all incorporated cities and villages in La Crosse County; and

WHEREAS, the La Crosse County Landfill Conceptual Natural Resource Management Plan & Trail and Recreation Master Plan has established the goal for the Landfill Trail System to connect with regional and City trails; and

WHEREAS, the City of Onalaska is a member of the La Crosse Area Planning Committee (LAPC), Metropolitan Planning Organization, which has approved the 2035 Coulee Regional Bicycle Plan recommending a continuous off-road facility along STH 16 between La Crosse and West Salem; and

WHEREAS, the LAPC's Committee on Transit and Active Transportation has proposed establishing and signing a regional bicycle route connecting south La Crosse to downtown West Salem along an alignment to include the STH 16 Trail.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Onalaska does hereby support the STH 16 Onalaska Multi-use Connector Trail project to complete a 9-mile continuous off-road trail within STH 16 right-of-way between Onalaska and West Salem.



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



Scope: The Basic Services to be provided by Consultant:

SEH and the City of Onalaska have completed a Preliminary Design of the Greens Coulee reservoir that was completed in August 2019. The recommendations included a preferred tank location and cast in place construction methods that was approved by the Public Works Committee in early September. Below is the final design scope of services associated with that request:

Final Design:

Task I: Civil Site Design

1. Supplementary Topographic Survey of preferred site, water main routes, access routes, and estimated location of the proposed tank (estimated 1-day)
2. Final site design for access to the water reservoir.
 - a. Create access alignments along existing walking trail for temporary access for construction vehicles and evaluate cut, fill and clearing & grubbing areas.
 - b. Compare above information with proposed structural bank stabilization measures and coordinate these concepts with structural engineer to identify cost savings or safety measures.
 - c. Complete final tank foundation slope limits by coordinating with Water and Structural engineer for options that minimize clearing and grubbing, excess material and hillside stabilization.
3. Final water main design from Quarry Lane to water reservoir site.
4. Final storm sewer design from water reservoir site to Quarry Lane.
5. Final construction site erosion control design.
6. Prepare cost estimates corresponding to 60% design & final design.
7. Prepare Wisconsin DNR Notice of Intent Permit (erosion control) application.
8. Prepare final site grading, utility, erosion control, foundation excavation plans and specifications.
9. Respond to bidder questions and substitution requests for civil discipline.

- 6. Oversee bidding process and compile plans and specifications from all disciplines.
- 7. Prepare final water process and vendor equipment cost estimates.
- 8. Prepare cost estimates corresponding to 60% design & final design.



Payments to Consultant for Services and Expenses
Using the Hourly Basis Option

The Agreement for Professional Services is amended and supplemented to include the following agreement of the parties:

A. Hourly Basis Option

The Client and Consultant select the hourly basis for payment for services provided by Consultant. Consultant shall be compensated monthly. Monthly charges for services shall be based on Consultant's current billing rates for applicable employees plus charges for expenses and equipment.

Consultant will provide an estimate of the costs for services in this Agreement. It is agreed that after 90% of the estimated compensation has been earned and if it appears that completion of the services cannot be accomplished within the remaining 10% of the estimated compensation, Consultant will notify the Client and confer with representatives of the Client to determine the basis for completing the work.

Compensation to Consultant based on the rates is conditioned on completion of the work within the effective period of the rates. Should the time required to complete the work be extended beyond this period, the rates shall be appropriately adjusted.

B. Expenses

The following items involve expenditures made by Consultant employees or professional consultants on behalf of the Client. Their costs are not included in the hourly charges made for services and shall be paid for as described in this Agreement but instead are reimbursable expenses required in addition to hourly charges for services:

1. Transportation and travel expenses.
2. Long distance services, dedicated data and communication services, teleconferences, Project Web sites, and extranets.
3. Lodging and meal expense connected with the Project.
4. Fees paid, in the name of the Client, for securing approval of authorities having jurisdiction over the Project.
5. Plots, Reports, plan and specification reproduction expenses.
6. Postage, handling and delivery.
7. Expense of overtime work requiring higher than regular rates, if authorized in advance by the Client.
8. Renderings, models, mock-ups, professional photography, and presentation materials requested by the Client.
9. All taxes levied on professional services and on reimbursable expenses.
10. Other special expenses required in connection with the Project.
11. The cost of special consultants or technical services as required. The cost of subconsultant services shall include actual expenditure plus 10% markup for the cost of administration and insurance.

The Client shall pay Consultant monthly for expenses.

C. Equipment Utilization

The utilization of specialized equipment, including automation equipment, is recognized as benefiting the Client. The Client, therefore, agrees to pay the cost for the use of such specialized equipment on the project. Consultant invoices to the Client will contain detailed information regarding the use of specialized equipment on the project and charges will be based on the standard rates for the equipment published by Consultant.

The Client shall pay Consultant monthly for equipment utilization.
