



THE FIRE HYDRANTS ON YOUR STREET!




# CINDER'S FIRE INSPECTION CHECKLIST


- ELECTRIC CORDS ARE IN GOOD CONDITION
- ALL SMOKE DETECTORS ARE TESTED BY A GROWN-UP
- ALL ESCAPE ROUTES ARE CLEAR FOR EMERGENCIES
- WINDOW CURTAINS ARE AWAY FROM CANDLES, STOVETOPS, FIREPLACES
- THE CLOTHES DRYER VENT IS CLEAN
- A GROWN-UP ALWAYS STAYS IN THE KITCHEN WHEN FOOD IS COOKING ON THE STOVETOP
- EXTENSION CORDS ARE NOT UNDER RUGS OR IN A WALKING AREA
- FURNACES & CHIMNEYS ARE CLEAN & INSPECTED EVERY YEAR
- SPACE HEATERS ARE USED SAFELY AND TURNED OFF WHEN YOU'RE GONE.
- CONDUCT A FIRE DRILL WITH EVERYONE IN YOUR HOUSE

# DO YOUR PART FOR KITCHEN SAFETY!

THINGS LIKE TOWELS, CURTAINS, AND PAPER SHOULD BE KEPT 3 FEET AWAY FROM THE STOVE. IF THEY ARE TOO CLOSE TO A HOT STOVE, THEY MIGHT CATCH ON FIRE.





TURN THE HANDLES OF POTS AND PANS AWAY

NEVER RUN IN THE KITCHEN





ALWAYS WIPE UP SPILLS AND PICK UP DROPPED


