Permit Fees will double if work is commenced before permit is issued

New Electrical/Low Voltage Permit Fee instructions:

Any electrical work associated with **Fire Alarm Systems** regardless of voltages shall require an electrical permit without exception.

Commercial Electrical/Low Voltage Calculation Instructions:

If square footage is used for calculating the building permit: Use that amount multiplied by \$0.15 (Commercial & Multi-Family) plus \$95.00 BASE FEE, plus service size of new or upgraded service (if applicable) plus any additional meters to calculate your total permit amount.

If square footage is not available for calculating: Take \$95.00 BASE FEE, plus service size of new or upgraded service (if applicable) plus any additional meters, plus \$95.00 miscellaneous work (includes one (1) inspection) if more than one (1) inspection is required add \$95.00 for each additional inspection.

Residential Electrical/Low Voltage Calculation Instructions:

If square footage is used for calculating the building permit: Use that amount multiplied by \$0.11 plus \$95.00 BASE FEE to calculate your total permit amount.

If square footage is not available for calculating: Take \$95.00 BASE FEE, plus \$55.00 for upgraded service (if applicable) plus \$95.00 miscellaneous work (includes one (1) inspection). If more than one (1) inspection is required add \$95.00 for each additional inspection.

Exceptions per City of Onalaska Ordinance 15-1-72 1) & 3):

No permits are required for WI Licensed Electrical Contractors for any One or Two-Family dwelling electrical work that involves a total labor and material value under \$1,000.00 or for low voltage electrical work that involves a total labor and material value under \$10,000.

No permits are required for any individual, business, entity who files a Certificate of Insurance with coverage amount allowed by the City of Onalaska for any low voltage electrical work (under 100 volts) that involves a total labor and material under \$200.00. Note: The conversion to light emitting diodes (L.E.D.'s) on/in signage regardless of material/labor value will not require an electrical permit.
