Public Fire Protection Service

Public fire protection service includes the use of hydrants for fire protection service only and such quantities of water as may be demanded for the purpose of extinguishing fires within the service area. This service shall also include water used for testing equipment and training personnel. For all other purposes, the metered or other rates set forth, or as may be filed with the Public Service Commission, shall apply.

Municipal Charge:

The annual charge for public fire protection service to the City of Onalaska shall be \$395,983. The utility may bill for this amount in equal installments.

Direct Charge:

Under Wis. Stat. § 196.03(3)(b), the municipality has chosen to have the utility bill the remaining public fire protection service charge to the retail general service customers.

Customers who are provided service under Schedules Mg-1R, Mg-1NR, Ug-1, or Sg-1 shall also be subject to the charges in this schedule according to the size of their primary meter. Irrigation class meters are not subject to the charges in this schedule.

Plus Volume Charges:

All water used quarterly: \$2.52 per 100 cubic feet

Billing: Bills for water service are rendered quarterly and become due and payable upon issuance following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 3 percent but not less than 50 cents will be added to bills not paid within 20 days of issuance. This ONE-TIME 3 percent late payment charge will be applied only to any unpaid balance for the current billing period’s usage. This late payment charge is applicable to all customers. The utility customer may be given a written notice that the bill is overdue no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment or satisfactory arrangement for payment is made within the next 10 days, service may be disconnected pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. PSC 185.

Combined Metering: Volumetric meter readings will be combined for billing if the utility for its own convenience places more than one meter on a single water service lateral. Multiple meters placed for the purpose of identifying water not discharged into the sanitary sewer are not considered for utility convenience and shall not be combined for billing. This requirement does not preclude the utility from combining readings when metering configurations support such an approach. Meter readings from individually metered separate service laterals shall not be combined for billing purposes.

Additional meters placed on the same service lateral as the primary meter for the purpose of identifying water that is not discharged into the sanitary sewer shall be classified as irrigation meters. Volumetric readings from irrigation meters shall be billed at the applicable irrigation class rate and may not be combined with readings from other meters on the same service lateral for billing purposes.

Residential Class includes residential and multifamily residential customers. Residential customers include single-family homes, duplexes, and individually metered condominiums, apartment buildings, and mobile home parks. Multifamily residential customers include master-metered multifamily dwelling units such as condominiums, apartment buildings, and mobile home parks.

Nonresidential Class includes commercial, industrial, and public authority customers. Commercial customers include business entities and institutions, except governmental entities, that provide goods or services. Churches and parochial schools are not governmental and are classified as commercial. Industrial customers include customers who are engaged in the manufacture or production of goods. Public Authority customers include any department, agency, or entity of local, state, or federal government, including public schools, colleges, and universities

All water used quarterly: \$3.20 per 100 cubic feet

Billing: Same as Schedule Mg-1R.

Combined Metering: Same as Schedule Mg-1R.

Irrigation Class includes customers who have water service provided primarily for landscape irrigation. For the purpose of this schedule, landscape irrigation includes the use of water to sustain crops, lawns, or landscapes on any residential, commercial, industrial, or public authority property, including water used for irrigating athletic fields, parks, and golf courses. Irrigation customers include those customers that have multiple meters installed on a single lateral for the purpose of measuring water that is not discharged to the sanitary sewer system. The utility shall classify each additional meter as an irrigation meter and treat each meter as a separate general service customer.

Wholesale Water Service

Wholesale water service to the La Crosse Water Utility for water used in the La Crosse International Industrial Park shall be provided at the following rates:

- Administrative Charge: \$50.00 per quarter
- Volume Charge: Applicable volume charges per Schedule Mg-1NR*
- Public Fire Protection Charge: Apply 25 percent surcharge (to volume charge)
- Private Fire Protection Charge: Apply charges per Schedule Upf-1

* For billing purposes, the accumulated industrial customer readings will be furnished by the La Crosse Water Utility.

Billing: Same as Schedule Mg-1NR.
