Winter Alternate Side Parking Enforcement Paused in Onalaska

In consideration of the unusually warm weather and lack of notable snow fall, the Onalaska Common Council voted to pause enforcement of Winter Alternate Side Parking Regulations through March 15, 2024, when the parking regulations normally end. In the event of a winter snow event that may require plowing, generally 2" or more, the Public Works Director may reinstate enforcement for a forty-eight (48) hour period. If that occurs, the City will post it on social media and the City's website, notify news outlets as well as alert people through our mobile alert system Smart911. You can sign up for Smart911 alerts by going to Smart911.com and clicking sign up in the right-hand corner and opting in to notification for the City of Onalaska.
