It needs to include size, location, property boundaries and nearby structures. The diagram also needs to show the distance from the coop/enclosed run to the side and rear lot lines of the property. If there are no changes listed above, this is not required for renewals.
_____	I understand the following requirements regarding coop size & setbacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a minimum of 2 sq. ft. per bird • Maintain at least 25 ft. from any residence • If the Coop is greater than 25 sq. ft. I will need to obtain a building permit. • The Coop will need to be at least 10 ft. from the property line & and structures on the applicant's lot or adjacent lots.

_____	I certify that the poultry and poultry products are primarily for personal non-commercial use and that no commercial sales for this residence or any residential area within the city is permitted.

<hr/>	I understand that no parcel shall be allowed more than three (3) female chickens and that no roosters are allowed.
<hr/>	I agree, in consideration of the granting of this license, to comply with the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and the provisions of the Municipal Code of Ordinances of the City of Onalaska.
<hr/>	I understand that the City of Onalaska will contact all abutting property owners regarding the Keeping of Chickens License application. Provided a minimum of 51% of abutting property owners do not object and applicant provides all required application materials, the Keeping of Chicken License will be granted.
<hr/>	I understand that all chicken coops shall be kept in a clean sanitary condition free from objectional odors and shall be subject to inspection and approval of the City of Onalaska and La Crosse County Public Health Department or their agents.
<hr/>	I understand property owners of chickens need to register with the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection pursuant to Section 95.51 of the Wis. Stats. and ATCP17 of the Wis. Adm. Code.
