EARLY AFTERNOON ACCIDENT IN ONALASKA

On Sunday September 30th at 1:45 p.m. the Onalaska Police Department responded to an accident with injuries on Hwy 157 south at Exit #4 of Interstate 90. Upon arrival at the scene Officers determined that a motorcycle traveling southbound on Hwy 157 struck a vehicle turning onto Hwy 157 North. The motorcycle then struck a second vehicle which was also waiting to turn onto Hwy 157 North. As the injury to the motorcycle driver was serious the State Patrol was summoned to the scene. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to Gundersen Lutheran where he underwent surgery last evening. The Wisconsin State Patrol is in the process of doing the accident reconstruction.

The name of the motorcycle driver is not being released as his condition is currently unknown. The drivers of the other vehicles were uninjured. There is no further information releasable as this incident is still under active investigation.
